Socio-Educational Survey of 5.97 Crore Population of Karnataka

In a record time of 2 months (April and May 2015) - Socio-Educational Survey of 5.97 Crore Population of Karnataka was conducted. Every person was surveyed on 55 parameters. These parameters will determine relative backwardness across 1000+ caste and sub-caste. To effectively conduct the survey 1.1 lakh enumerators were trained.

Successful Implementation of Innovative Schemes of Financial Assistance

89 Students belonging to Backward Classes were given grant for three years to Study Abroad. Technology was used to bring transparency and effectiveness in selection. Merit Scholarship to 2500 meritorious SSLC/PUC Students and 1000 PH.D. Students were implemented on the eve of centennial celebrations of Dr. Devraj Urs.
